 Tim Adams, NCC had dealt with a number of pot hole issues and the 20mph project which will go to the portfolio holder soon. A speed counter has been organised for the project and paid for from Tim's budget. Discussion took place on linking FP5 and BR11 and assistance will be sought from the Trails Officer at NCC. Wellspring Road is being investigated by Highways and the Ecologists.
